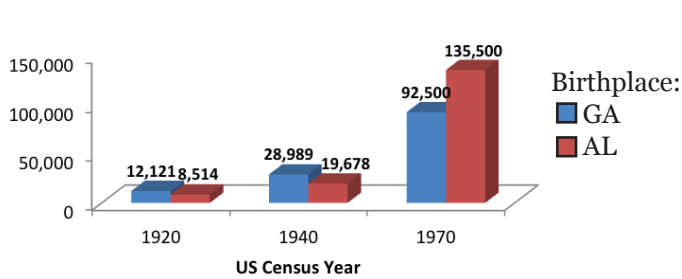

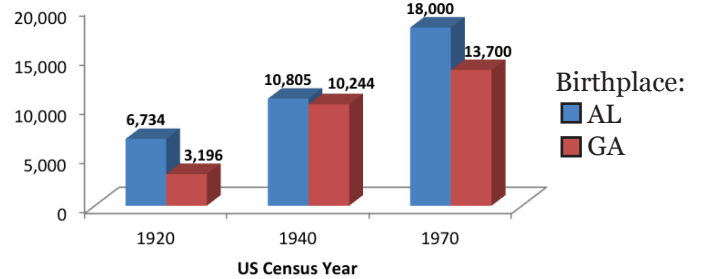
Black Residents of New York



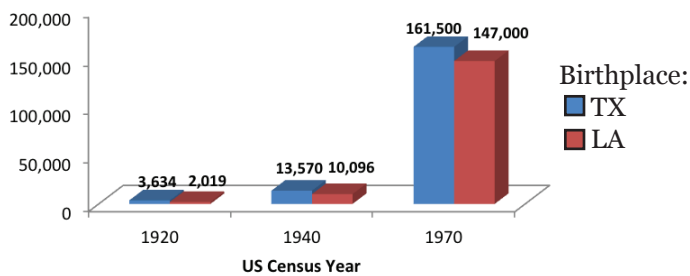

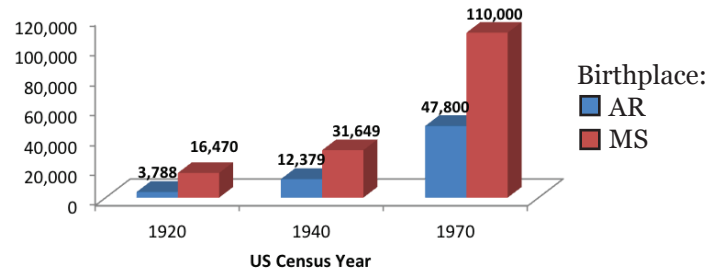

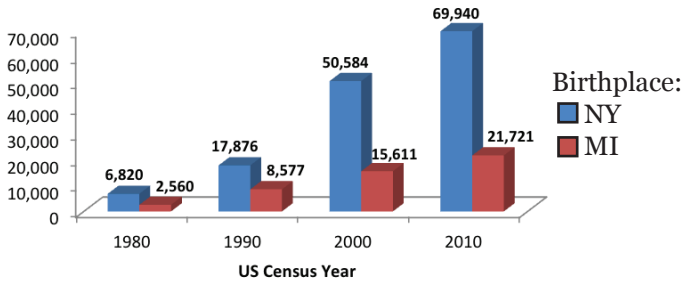

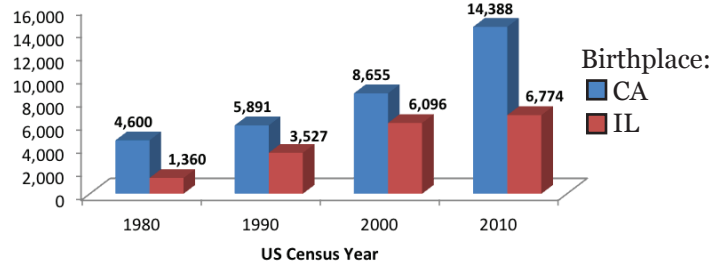

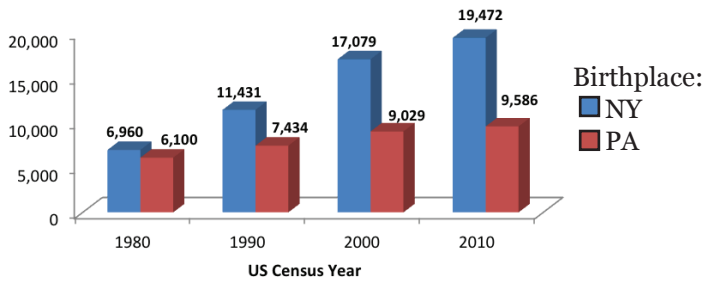

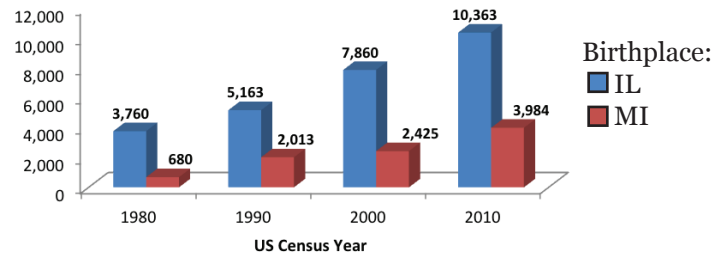

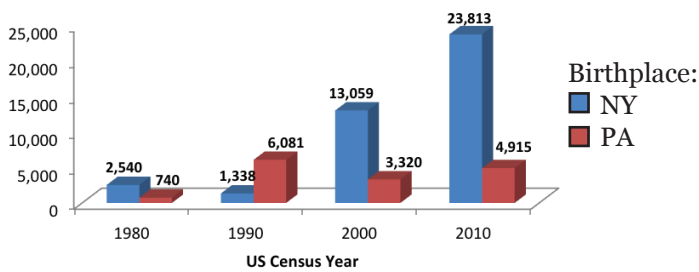

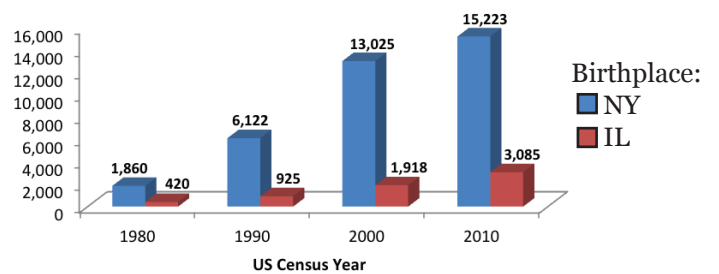
